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Dear families,

As we enter December, we have several exciting events happening in school:

19th December – School finishes for the Christmas holidays

6th January – School returns for Spring term – 8:45am

Unfortunately, we are having to increase the price of school dinners to £2.40 a day, which is £12 a week. By doing this we are still not covering the full costs of a school dinner and it also brings in line with what other schools locally are charging. We appreciate that the cost of living is increasing and that every aspect of life has an increase cost but unfortunately, our school budget can't sustain only charging £2.20 a day.

As an incentive to continue the children's great work on attendance and punctuality we are doing a Christmas Attendance Tracker – every time your child arrives at school and on time between 1st – 19th December they will mark it on their sheet. If, by the 19th December, they have 5 marks they will have a hot chocolate, 10 marks they will have 10 minutes extra play and 15 marks will mean they get a mystery gift!
