Dear families,

We are now going into the final week of this academic year and I can't believe how fast this year has gone! It doesn't feel that long ago that I was writing to you in September to welcome you back into school.

We have had a really busy year! Just this half term, we have had; Y6 go on their residential, 26 children from Y4 – Y6 went to London for the day, Nursery went to the Grapes Garden, Reception went to New Brighton Beach, Y1 went to Chester Zoo, Y2 went to Crosby Beach, Y3 and Y4 to Liverpool Museum, Y5 went to the World Museum, children from across the school representing Windsor in sports competitions and Y4 children attending a Debate competition. All of these curriculum enhancements have enabled the children to gain valuable first-hand experiences which in turn supports their learning.

On Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> July, all children will come home with their end of year reports. These reports will show how much progress your child has made and the achievements they have had this year. Please make sure you share and discuss the report with your child, I'm sure most of you will be really proud of your child's achievements.

Last week we had our Inclusion Quality Mark review and we have once again been reaccredited with Centre of Excellence. The assessor spoke with children, parents, staff, leaders and Governors. He was really impressed with the inclusive nature of the school. In his report he states *"Windsor Community Primary School exemplifies what it means to be a truly inclusive school.....Pupils themselves summed the school up best. They described Windsor as "welcoming," "diverse," "inclusive," "safe" and "kind" which reflected the words used by parents and staff like "family," "community," and "second home." These words were consistently reflected in everything observed throughout the review. They are the product of a school community where inclusion is not driven by policies or interventions*



*alone but by deeply held values that influence every interaction, every decision, and every aspect of school life. All stakeholders were proud to be part of this community.”*

Miss Swift is going on a sabbatical for a year, we wish her all the best and safe travels – we look forward to welcoming Miss Swift back September 2027.
